CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

This permit is given to and accepted by the permittee upon the following conditions.

- 1. That said permittee will conform to the statutes and to the ordinances of the Town, now and hereafter in force.
- 2. That work will be at all times, under the direction and control of the Superintendent of the Public Works, or his authorized agent.
- 3. That said permittee will cause the excavation and obstruction to be properly fenced and protected during the whole time the street is open and obstructed and that he will place and maintain from the beginning of twilight through the whole night, over or near the place so opened, occupied, obstructed or used, and over or near any dirt, gravel or other material, when there upon or to be used by him. A light or lights fixed to said fence or in some other proper-place, manner sufficient to protect travelers from injury.
- 4. That said permittee will identify and save the Town from all claims for damages or injury whatsoever that may arise from the excavation in or occupation of said street.
- 5. That the permittee will provide and maintain a safe and convenient way and passage for pedestrians and vehicles around or over such place.
- 6. That said permittee will put said street in good condition and satisfactory repair before the expiration of the time above mentioned and in case repairs to the street surface become necessary during the period of one year, from the completion of the work done under this permit and because of said work the said permittee agrees to restore the same to a satisfactory condition within two days after notice received to make such repairs, in case of failure to do so, said permittee agrees to identify said Town and to reimburse it for any or all liability or expense incurred or suffered by reason of such failure.
- 7. All fill must be compacted in 12 inch lifts by mechanical compactors. The top 12 inches shall be selected gravel, of which no stones shall be greater than 3 inches shall and compacted to 95% density in two six-inch layers prior to laying street surface.
- 8. The street surface shall be bituminous concrete, Type I and must have minimum compacted depth of 3 inches in all instances.
- 9. On all openings the permittee agrees to clean vertical cuts with mechanical cutters and the joints on all street surfaces shall be sealed with Bitumem joint material.
- 10. In some cases a temporary surface treatment may be required with restoration after a 30 to 90 day settlement period.
- 11. This permit may be revoked at any time by the Superintendent of Public Works.
